A NOTE FROM SAFETY DIRECTOR BRIAN THOMAS

Hazard Recognition Program

SBMI has implemented a new program in an effort to engage all employees in hazard recognition. We are all exposed to hazards every day and most of the time they are the same hazards day after day. When you work in the same environment on a daily basis, it is natural to become comfortable with the environment and the hazards associated with it. We think the Hazard Recognition Program will challenge us to look at our work environment and recognize the hazards in it.

The way that the program works is:

1. Each week a topic will be selected for discussion. An example might be "pinch points."
2. Each employee will be given a card that has 5 blank lines. These blank lines are to be used by the employee to document 5 examples of the topic designated for that week. If hazards are found, employees need to bring them to the attention of their supervisor so they can be corrected immediately.
3. Employees that identify 5 items on their card are eligible to submit their card for a drawing.
4. A drawing will be held each week. Only cards that are 100% complete are eligible. You can't win if you don't participate.

Hazards in the construction industry change quickly. We need everyone working together to recognize and eliminate hazards in the workplace.
